Prevention Strategies for Construction's Focus Four Hazards Program

According to National Safety Council *Injury Facts® 2007 Edition*, in 2005 there was an estimate of 414,900 nonfatal injuries or illnesses in the construction industry. Not being aware of The Focus Four Hazards can cause many injuries in the construction industry.

Owners, employers, managers, or employees in the construction or contracting industry who attend this program will learn to:

- Identify the Focus Four Hazard areas: falls, electrocution, excavation, and trenching, and struck-by.
- Define commonly used terms relating to and recognize regulatory standards and requirements pertaining to the Focus Four Hazards.
- Identify specific prevention strategies for the Focus Four Hazards that cause the most injuries and fatalities.
- Identify specific prevention strategies for the Focus Four Hazards by incidents.
- Recognize risk-taking behaviors relating to the Focus Four Hazards and identify methods for addressing them.
