OSHA TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

The Code of Federal Regulation for General Industry, CFR 1910.151(b) Medical Services and First Aid, states: *"(b) In the absence of an infirmary, clinic, or hospital in near proximity to the workplace which is used for the treatment of all injured employees, a person or persons shall be adequately trained to render first aid..."* (The full text and clarification of training requirements under CFR 1910.151 can be found on-line at <http://www.osha.gov>).

With few exceptions, every employer, regardless of size, is required to have enough employees trained in First Aid & CPR to quickly respond to the hazards which can be reasonably expected to occur in the workplace.
