Alcohol, Drugs, and Driving Awareness Course (ADDAC) 7-Hour Course Outline

Educational programs comprise only one countermeasure in the post-detection portion of an impaired-driver control system. However, when considered as a single component in a system of countermeasures (that includes enforcement, adjudication, public information, and counseling) educational programs make a positive contribution to alcohol/drug traffic safety by reducing the recidivism of multiple offense or impaired drivers.
