The second edition of the National Safety Council's Pediatric First Aid, CPR, and AED course has been approved for Class A and Class B Child Care Centers in Louisiana. This approval is for both CPR training and First Aid training, and runs from November 1, 2006 through December 31, 2008. A copy of the approval letter is enclosed for your review and files.

If you teach a Pediatric First Aid, CPR, and AED course to day care providers in your state, please fill out the course name on the certificates as follows. Inspectors who monitor the course completion cards for Class A and Class B Child Care Centers will be looking for this exact wording:

The green, CPR certificate should read:

Adult & Child CPR and AED and Infant CPR

The blue, First Aid certificate should read:

Child and Infant (Pediatric) First Aid

If you teach an adult first aid course in Louisiana, the blue First Aid certificate should read:

Adult First Aid.


